

Senior Students Swarm to Sundays at JASA

More than 170 people have enrolled in the spring semester of Sundays at JASA, held at John Jay College of the City University. "Alan Weisman's classes are far and away the most popular," reports Program Director Sara Tornay. The program has to add extra chairs to accommodate the 55 students who have registered for Gotcha!, his class on investigative reporting. Each weekly session draws on Weisman's extensive experience as a producer on 60 Minutes and other TV shows. His current events class has 35 students, all of them eager to express their views on important issues.

Another popular offering is Ed Sommerfeld's "From Cabaret to Films," which looks at the careers of Milton Berle, Barbra Streisand, and other TV, film, and stage stars who began their careers in the Catskills.
