Medicaid can help cover expenses such as **doctor visits, hospital stays, prescription medications, and other healthcare services.**



Medicaid can help pay for **long-term care services.**



Medicaid can help fill in Medicare coverage gaps by providing **additional benefits and reducing out-of-pocket costs.**



Medicaid can provide access to a wide range of services such as **transportation to medical appointments, case management, and certain preventive care services.**

- Assessment and planning session

- Assistance with Pooled Income Trusts
- Consultation for approval/certification review, eligibility maintenance and annual redetermination requirements
